

Roseland Presbyterian Church's Manse has not been used as a residence for the Pastor for the last four and half years.

RPC's small congregation does not anticipate that the manse will be used in the future. Both the Session and the Congregational voted unanimously to sell the manse.

Maintaining RPC's manse and surrounding property has taken valuable financial and human resources that could be used for RPC's creative ministries for mission and outreach in the Roseland Community.

At the present time, even with a Temporary Supply Pastor who serves one third time, RPC has begun various Outreach educational ministries in the community..

Last year, RPC offered a Short Course on World Religions. This fall RPC will offer a class on the Labyrinth Walk.

The financial Interest that will come from the Sale of the Manse will be used to continue to provide educational nurture in the Roseland community and support other kinds of Outreach ventures that RPC is committed to explore and undertake.
